## Daredevil or butterfly, rocker or mystic?

Austria's GUNAR LETZBOR in VIRTUOSO VIOLIN
28 & 29 October, 2, 4 & 5 November 2005 City Recital Hall, Angel Place SYDNEY

"The international press call him 'daredevil', 'butterfly', 'rocker' and 'mystic'", says **Paul Dyer**, Brandenburg Artistic Director.

"Gunar Letzbor's reviews indicate that the Austrian wonder-baroque violinist will ignite the stage during his Brandenburg debut as guest director and soloist in *Virtuoso Violin*, not only because of his "dazzling violin playing" but also his commanding stage and physical presence."

In <u>Switzerland</u>, a Letzbor performance was described in this way: "When he arrives on stage, he is impressive. Physically. Gunar Letzbor is tall like an athlete! Not a thin marathoner, but rather like a hammer thrower. Almost monumental. But when the first notes rise… surprise! The violinist has the delicacy of a butterfly."

In his home country Austria, the critics have acclaimed "his absolute mastery" and his ability to "delve into a cosmos of intellectual beauty" and "speak with mystical clarity on his instrument."

The <u>French press</u> says that this "original and erudite interpreter" isn't really what you'd expect of a leading baroque musician: "He didn't take off his shirt, but under it beats the heart of a rocker. This Austrian violinist, standing at two metres, is handsome like a movie star."

Gunar was awarded the prestigious Cannes Classical Award for a recording with his own baroque ensemble **Ars Antiqua Austria**, which plays to great acclaim throughout Europe and in the USA.

In *Virtuoso Violin*, Gunar will be soloist in concertos by **Vivaldi** and **Pergolesi**, as well as the revered **Bach Violin Concerto in E major**, one of classical music's greats.


