José Carreras loves sharing the stage with her & she has sung Björk & Sting with the Brodsky Quartet.

In May she stars in the first Brandenburg concert headlined by a mezzo soprano in 21 years.

This Perth mum is without doubt one of Australia's hottest classical music artists.

"Venus in voice and form" Opera-Opera

Fiona Campbell is one of the finest performers of her generation. As the preferred touring guest of international stars **José Carreras** and **Barbara Bonney**, her world is full of gorgeous gowns, standing ovations, limos, five-star hotels and wearing expensive diamonds on stage that require the constant presence of a security officer in the wings.

Between gigs Fiona drops the dresses and diamonds for a more domestic existence with her husband and children making their school lunches, or driving them to sport or music lessons.

This May, Fiona will become the first mezzo soprano to headline a Brandenburg concert in 21 years.

"The castrati were the vocal superstars of the baroque and composers wrote fantastic music for heroic male characters with high voices," says **Paul Dyer**, Brandenburg Artistic Director.

"For our very first concert we had a mezzo soprano as the guest artist. Since then I've only used male countertenors to perform the great castrato arias, including the legendary **Andreas Scholl** and **Philippe Jaroussky**."

"In modern times when these male roles are sung by women - generally mezzo sopranos or contraltos - they are known as 'pants roles'," explains Paul.

"In Fiona Campbell we have a singer who has the vocal prowess and commanding presence to pull off the triumphant heroes and tragic heroines of Handel's great operas. Her tone is so beautifully shaped. It has such a rich colour."

"If I had to pick one incredible moment in this concert, it would have to be *Lascia ch'io pianga*. It is one of the most exquisite arias you will ever hear. You listen to it and time stops. The world first heard Lascia in 1711 during Handel's Opera Rinaldo. It is the 300th anniversary of this work and we have this brilliant Australian bringing this immortal aria to life. It is going to be unforgettable.
